# English for Refugees and Asylees (ERA)

**Who is eligible?** Any refugee, SIV, or asylee who has been granted status within the last five years, and is living in Maryland.

**What documents do I need to register?**

1. Proof of immigration status, such as employment authorization card, I-94
2. Proof of residency, such as a lease agreement or a utility bill

**To prepare for registration**, provide required documents and your updated phone number to Lailuma Social via email at [sociallx@pgcc.edu](mailto:sociallx@pgcc.edu).

**Oral screening days:** We will call you to check your information in your native language and have an oral screening to prepare you for the actual test.

**In-person Placement Tests:**

During the registration over the phone, the registration team will let you know placement test date information.
